MOEN LAKE CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Renters must be at least 21 years of age. Renters are responsible for all their guests and children during their stay with us. Campers and their visitors will not hold Moen Lake Campground responsible for any loss of personal property or any injuries. This includes any injury from use of sports equipment. The campground owners and employees reserve the right to interpret and enforce all the rules for the benefit and safety of all.
- 2. All renters and day visitors must register in the office. All vehicles must display proper car tags. Any vehicle in the campground without the proper tags and registration with the office is subject to towing.
- 3. Check in time is at 3:00 p.m. and check out time is at 11:00 a.m. unless otherwise arranged with management. There will be a \$10.00 additional fee for all late check ins. Anytime after 8:00 p.m. is considered a late check in.
- 4. We do not charge extra for sunshine and WE DO NOT GIVE REFUNDS IF IT RAINS. Our cancellation policy is as follows: If you cancel in less than 2-14 days you will be charged for a 1 night stay. If you cancel in 2 days or less, or just fail to show, you will be charged for your entire stay. Cancellation of cabins, your down payment will not be refunded unless the vacancy is filled. If the vacancy is filled, you will receive your full down payment less a \$25.00 cancellation fee.
- 5. **QUIET HOURS** are from 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. After 11:00 p.m. your neighbors should not be able to hear your activities. Parents are responsible for the whereabouts, actions and safety of their children. Children are not to be left unsupervised at any time. All children and teenagers under the age of 18 must be back at their campsite or with their parents by 9:00 p.m.
- 6. Any person (adult or child) found stealing, damaging any property including trees, dealing or using drugs, causing injury to another person, etc. will be evicted from the campground immediately and prosecuted for any damages

accordingly. Anyone found violating the restrooms or showers in any way will be evicted. There is no smoking in the restrooms, showers, recreational hall or any common area buildings. **PLEASE, IF YOU OBSERVE ANY PERSON ABUSING THIS RULE, PLEASE INFORM MANAGEMENT IMMEDIATELY.**

- 7. Per Wisconsin State Laws there is only 1 camping unit and 1 tent (pop-up campers are considered 1 camping unit) allowed per site. Two vehicles are allowed per site. Campsites and campers shall be maintained in an orderly, neat and sanitary manner. **NO TRASH OR GARBAGE** outside of your camping unit.
- 8. The speed limit is 5 MPH. Any and all vehicles must adhere to this speed limit. If your car is leaving a dust trail, you are traveling too fast. Trucks over 3 tons are not permitted on the campground roads and must be parked in the parking lot behind the Recreational Hall. Please watch for children while driving in the campground.
- 9. Golf carts, ATVs, UTVs, mopeds and motorized scooters are allowed in the campground. Proof of insurance is required. YOU MUST BE 16 YEARS OR OLDER AND HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE TO OPERATE ANY MOTORIZED VEHICLE IN THE CAMPGROUND. These vehicles are also subject to the 5 MPH rule. Operation of vehicles is limited to the developed roads in the campground. Rough joy riding of any sport vehicles on park roads is prohibited. During quiet hours vehicle usage is limited to destination driving.
- 10. We do provide honey wagon service during your stay. The cost is \$10.00 and will need to be scheduled and paid for ahead of time. A dump station is located on the grounds and is free of charge. There is to be no dumping of any wastewater (including dishwater) on the grounds. Please use the dump station or honey wagon service. Do **NOT** dump any wastewater in bathrooms.
- 11. **DO NOT THROW CIGARETTE BUTTS OR ANY GARBAGE ON THE GROUND.** Please dispose of these in proper waste containers.

- 12. Garbage must be removed from your site when you leave. All garbage and recyclables must be separated accordingly. Aluminum cans are to be kept separate from other recyclables and placed in the designated area behind the Recreational Hall. Disposal of appliances, mattresses, metal, furniture, lawn chairs, bikes or any other large items is prohibited. Any individual found disposing of such contents will be fined \$200.00. If you are unsure of what can be disposed of, please ask management.
- 13. Excessive noise, excessive drunkenness, immoral and illegal conduct will not be tolerated. Please be considerate of your neighbors and the children surrounding you when you use foul language. Management reserves the right to contact the police for excessive violations. Please keep all radios, stereos, TVs, etc. at a reasonable sound level. If you are not in your camping area, your audio equipment should be turned off.
- 14. YOU MAY NOT BRING IN YOUR OWN FIREWOOD TO THE CAMPGROUND.

We sell firewood for your camping experience. No trees or limbs may be cut down (dead or alive). If there are fallen branches in your immediate area, please feel free to collect them and utilize them as firewood for free. No gathering of wood from the woods is permitted.

- 15. There is absolutely no digging or burial of wire or hoses. You may not move your fire ring without management approval. Campers will be charged for any damages caused by the digging or burial of anything on their campsite.
- 16. Campfires may only be made inside the provided fire pits. **NO BONFIRES** are allowed. Fires may not be any higher than 12 inches above the outside of the fire pit. Fires **MUST BE EXTINGUISHED** upon your departure or as you retire for the night. **PUT YOUR FIRE OUT COMPLETELY.** No burning of garbage or paper in the fire pits.
- 17. If you have a pet they are to be kept on a leash or tether at all times. The only area where they are allowed to roam free is in the provided dog park. If you are caught violating this rule, you will be asked to keep your pet inside your camper.

- 18. **NO FIREWORKS** are allowed in the campground.
- 19. No nailing of anything to any tree at any time. Anyone found violating this will be charged for a new tree.
